## **What to bring to the nursery:**

**DIAPER BAGS—labeled w/ child's name**

## OUR SICKNESS POLICY

To protect the health of the children in our nursery, please do not bring your children into the nursery when they exhibit any of the following symptoms:

- Unusual fatigue or irritability
- Colored discharge from nose or eyes
- Vomiting, diarrhea, uncontrollable cough
- Inflamed mouth and/or throat
- Rash or spots
- Fever (should be fever free for 24 hours)

Thank you for your cooperation in this matter. If your child develops any of these symptoms in the nursery, you will be notified immediately.

### Toddlers Walkers - age 2

All nursery room guidelines apply. In addition, the toddlers and preschoolers use David Cook's "*Bible in Life*" curriculum. Each Sunday, your little ones will have a snack, do an age appropriate craft, and hear the Bible story. Parents are provided with take home material to reinforce the Bible at home. We want to equip parents with ways to lead young children to love and serve a gracious and mighty savior!

### 3s & 4s

In our 9:00 am Preschool, we use David C Cook's, "Bible in Life" curriculum. Here they are invited to engage in a fun time of learning God's word, using various crafts and activities and begin to work on Bible Verse Memory.

Our 10:00 am Preschoolers are introduced to the Elevate curriculum as they participate in a large group worship time called, "Power Up". More information on Elevate and Power Up can be found in our elementary brochure.

Children also learn to serve others by donating to the poor throughout the year. Some examples of this are bringing used baby clothes for mission trips, filling baby bottles with coins to be given to local pregnancy centers, and Operation Christmas Child. ## Goals for Children...

- ***Kids led by parents through the help of the church***- Everyone needs a spiritual leader or teacher. This is true even more so for our little ones. It is our philosophy here at Cornerstone that our parents are strongly encouraged to take their role as spiritual leaders seriously. We as a church are also held responsible for that very important role as we support and equip our parents to follow through each and every day with the most important role of their life - leading their children to Christ and keeping them there.
